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STEM-orientation for high schools

A project led by Faculty of Mathematics and Sciences (JYU)

This project started on fall 2023 with eight high schools from northern Central Finland. The purpose is to increase interest to study STEM subjects and to support students in their studies. Students from different schools form peer support network that meets regularly online. The project also makes the University visible for high school students in a new and easily accessible way. Through multidisciplinary activities, the connection of the STEM subjects not only to each other, but also to other sciences such as skills and art subjects and humanities becomes clearer.
