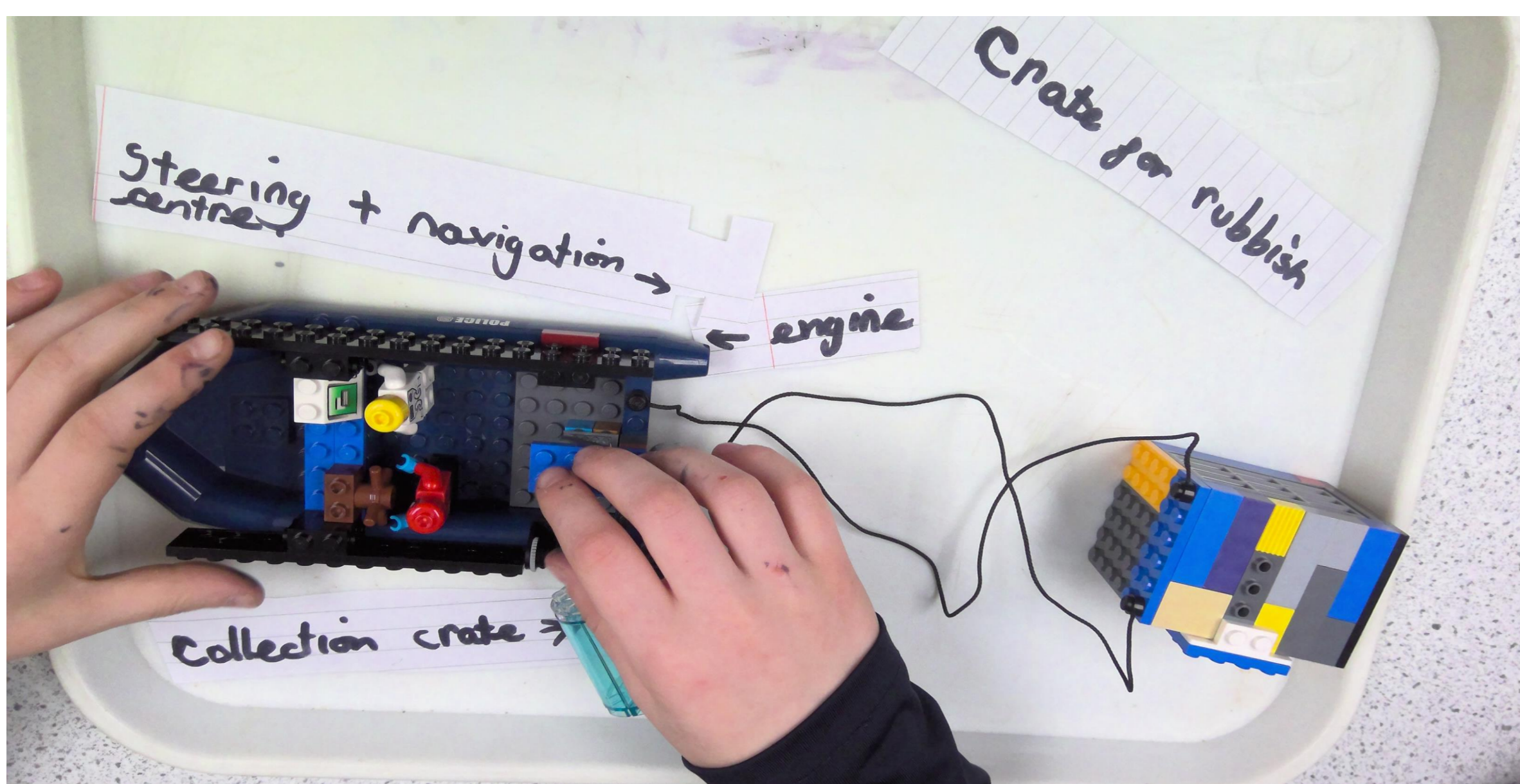
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Press Play - Sustainable Life on the Moon

Our project has looked at how we can travel and live sustainably on the Moon.

The project has been play-led based allowing pupils to lead their own learning where they designed, explored and evaluated their ideas on rocket designs to living pods.

We used the Sustainable Development Goals based on sustainable communities, partnership goals, affordable energy and used Lego as a modelling tool.



Artemis 2 project was an inspiration for the pupils at the start of their projects and gave them some ideas about how scientists work together. This gave the pupils the opportunity for purposeful enquiry with 'hands on minds on' the tasks

Conclusion: Being able to work with schools in different countries on a project gives your pupils a real opportunity to experience learning opportunities that would not usually be open to them. For us as teachers it has forged new friendships and opened the door to new projects in the future.
