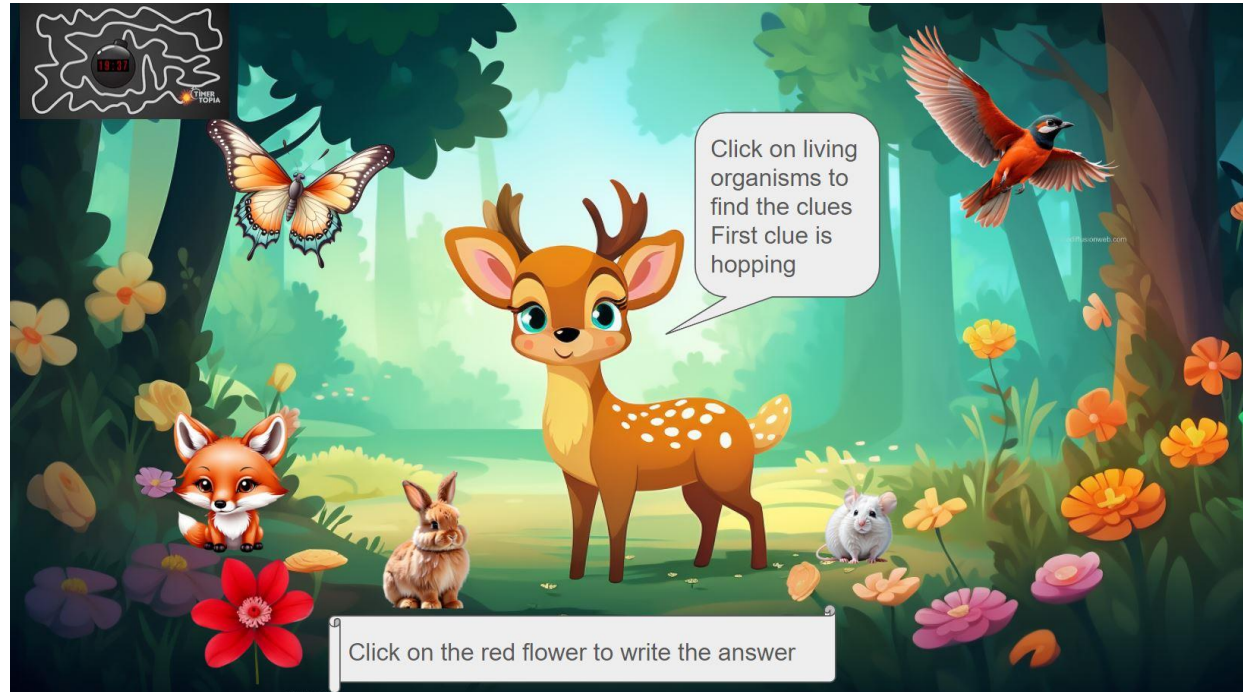
### Teaching Climate change in Primary Education

Climate change is a global environmental issue. We see it affecting our lives everyday. But what a struggle, trying to teach its scientific grounds to young students!

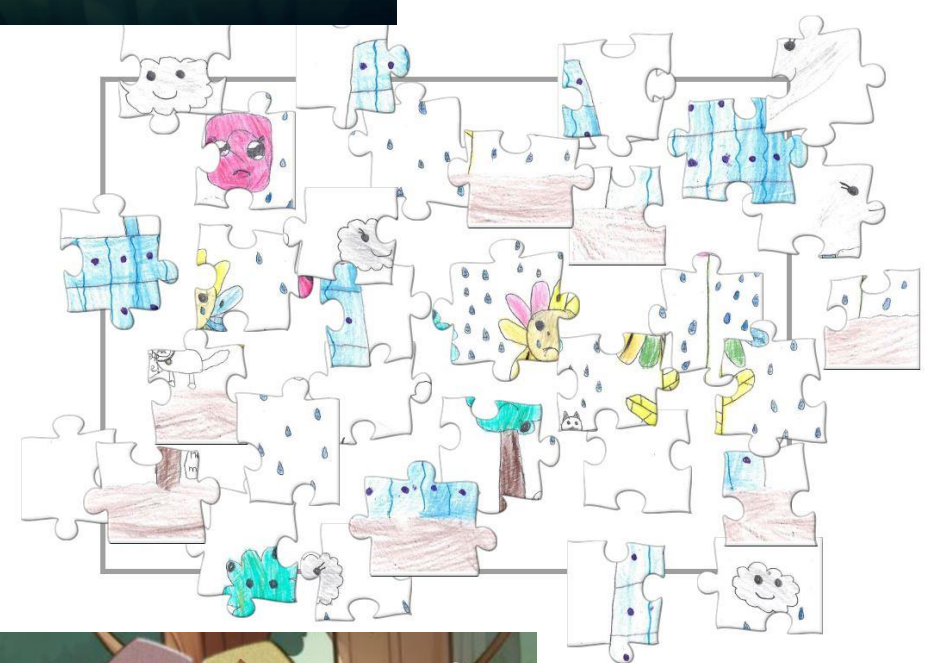
Our project was to get students learn about acid rain as a result of climate change. Why? How? What is the effect on living organisms? On buildings?

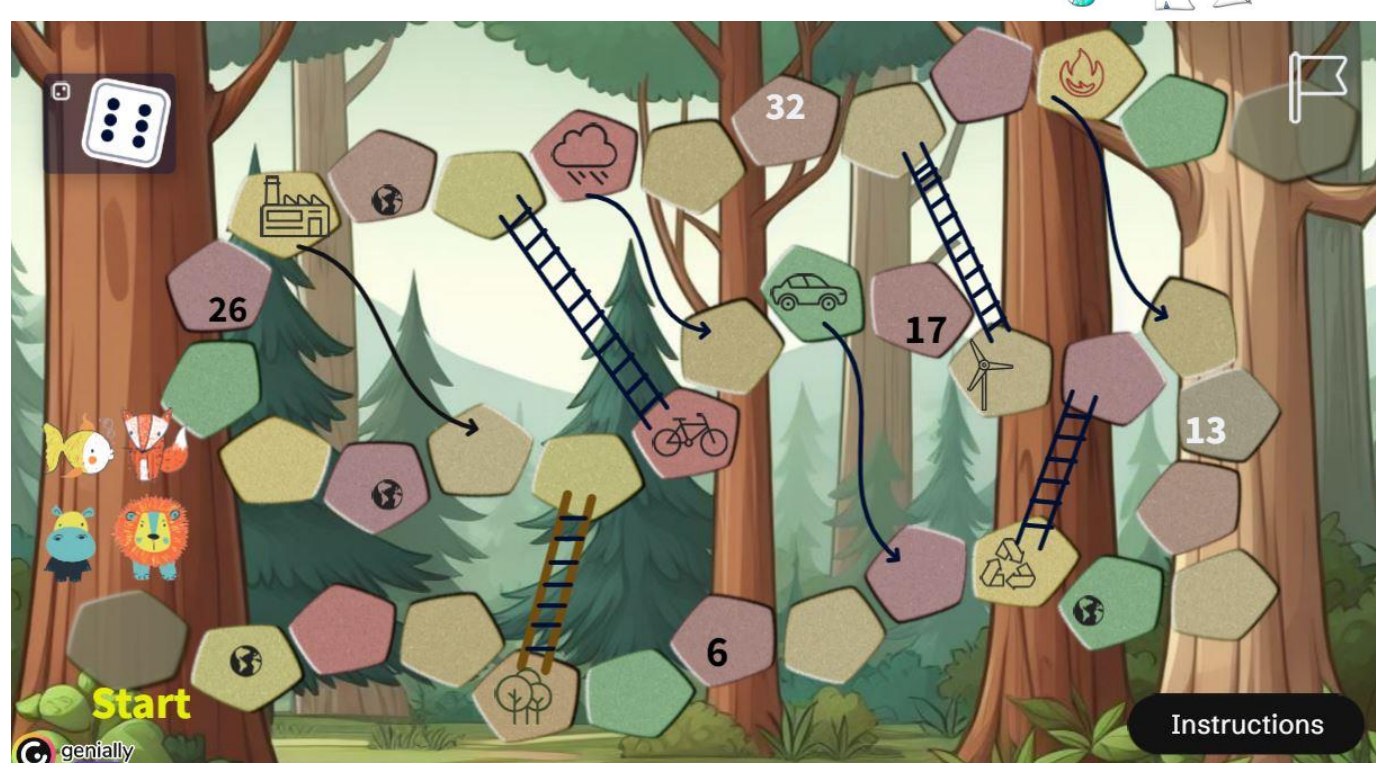
